



Since 1996, Beaverton City Library's Library On Wheels (LOW) program has helped get books in the hands of kids in child care centers and in-home child cares, kids who may have trouble regularly visiting the library in person.

LOW's primary service area is within the city, noted in tan on the map above. If space allows, we also serve the area within the blue boundaries.

Every three weeks, library staff bring a bag of paperback picture books to child care facilities, rotating the books between 65 child care classes in the Beaverton area. Library staff also provide storytimes when visiting some larger daycares.

In 2016, LOW served 11,000 children in child cares in Beaverton and the surrounding area.

Beaverton City Library's Library on Wheels (LOW) program visits child care facilities to share books and stories from the library!

We deliver a new selection of 20 books to child care centers and in-home family childcare centers every three weeks.

If you have a child care with five or more children who are of preschool age, our LOW storyteller can also provide a 15-minute storytime where we sing and read books!

Our LOW storyteller uses Early Literacy practices (talk, read, write, play and sing) to help children develop their language and literacy skills and prepare for future success in school.

Our goal is to provide books and promote the joy of reading to kids beyond the walls of our library building.
